

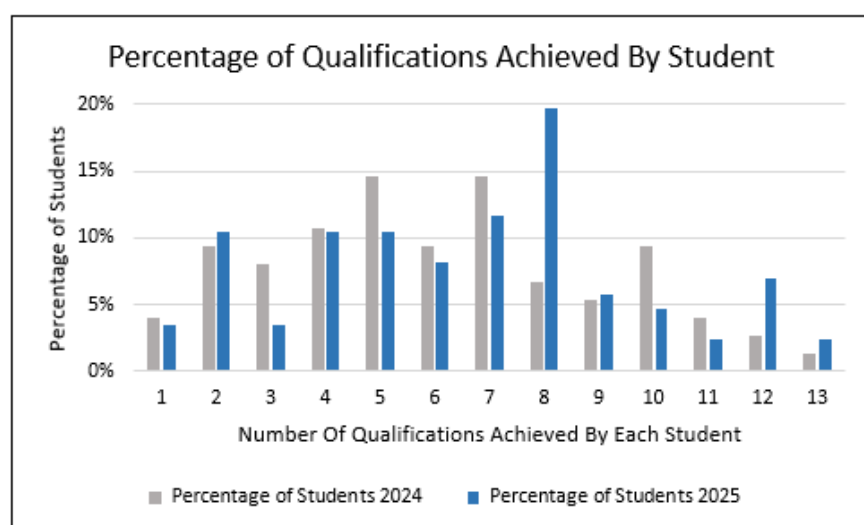


Exam Data

The number of students achieving **8** or more qualifications (Entry Level, Functional Skills, GCSE or Vocational qualifications) increased by **13%** this year from **29%** to **42%**. This shows that we have increased the variety of qualifications that we offer to our students both academically and vocationally and that staff are pushing our students to be the best version of themselves.

90% OF STUDENTS ACHIEVED A QUALIFICATION IN BOTH ENGLISH AND MATHS, AN **INCREASE OF 6%** FROM LAST YEAR.

Maths GCSEs

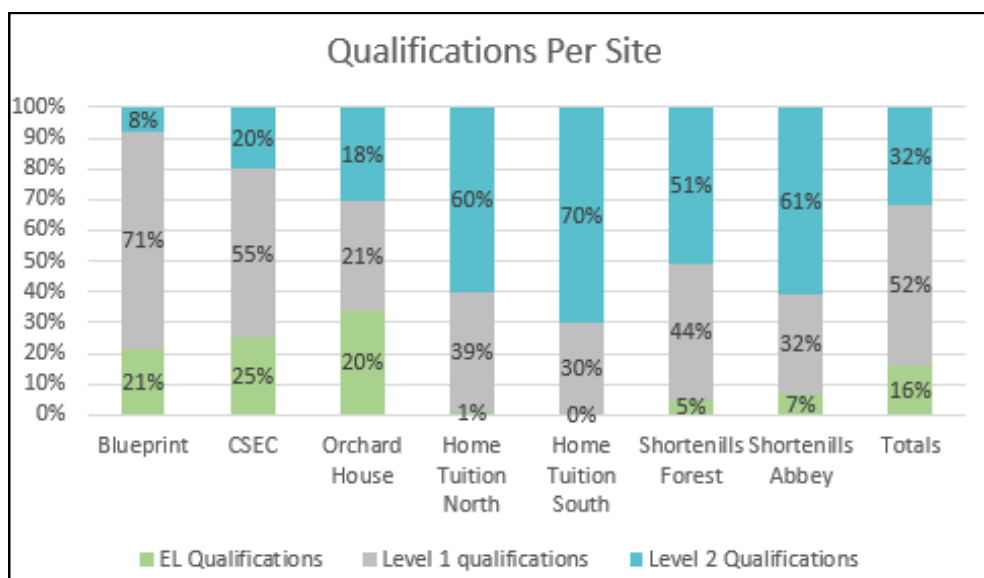
37% of students taking Maths GCSE left Aspire with a standard (4+) GCSE pass - **24%** in 2024

English & Maths GCSEs

The number of students leaving with a standard GCSE pass in English and Maths has increased by 1% from **16%** in 2024 to **17%** in 2025. The number of students leaving with a strong GCSE pass in English & Maths remained static at **6%**.

- **Entry Level** – English, Maths and Science
- **Level 1** – Vocational awards and certificates, GCSE results at grades 3, 2 or 1
- **Level 2** – Vocational awards and certificates, GCSE results at grades 4+

Vocational

90 vocational qualifications were awarded to students:

- **27** qualifications awarded to **17** Blueprint Students.
- **41** qualifications awarded to **22** CSEC Students.
- **22** Cooking and Hair & Beauty qualifications awarded to **22** Home Tuition and Shortenills (Both Forest and Abbey) Students.
